



**MOTORCYCLE 'RIDE DAY'
WHITSUNDAY RACEWAY
EASTER SATURDAY 7TH APRIL 2012**

Here's your chance to have a 'Ride Day' with your mates on the new Road Racing track at Whitsunday Raceway riding your own road bike. It's fun, it's fast, it's addictive and it's legal!

Bookings are open now. Just go to www.wmsc.org.au to download a Registration Form..... but be quick, numbers are limited!

WHAT'S IT COST AND WHAT DO I GET?

You'll get 5 sessions of approximately 15 minutes on the track during the day for \$120.00. Unless you already have an Annual Recreational Licence or an Annual Competition Licence, you'll need a Motorcycling Queensland Recreational Day Licence that we can issue you for \$20.00. That's it apart from any food and drink you want to buy at the track.

WHAT'S THE TRACK LIKE?

It's a brand new facility with a 1.1km bitumen track 8 metres wide. There are 6 right corners and 4 left. There's a Control Tower, Admin' and Canteen building and toilet facilities. It's at Lascelles Avenue, near Proserpine Airport just off the Bruce Highway.

WHAT BIKES ARE ALLOWED?

You can ride any capacity bike provided it is properly prepared... so yes, you can bring that 1000cc sports bike but remember, it's a smaller circuit and lesser capacity bikes will probably be easier to handle!

WHAT ABOUT PEOPLE WHO ARE NOT FAST RIDERS?

You simply select one of four groups to ride in. Fast, Medium Fast, Medium or Novice. Just choose the group you think you'll be comfortable in. If the Track Supervisor thinks a rider is in a wrong group he'll move the rider up or down depending on ability.

WHAT ABOUT RACING LEATHERS AND ALL THE SAFETY GEAR?

The Fast and Medium Fast groups need full one or two piece leathers with proper back protectors. As a minimum, the Medium and Novice groups can wear jeans and a leather jacket but should try to wear leather trousers or a 'Draggin Jeans' type product. Naturally all riders need a full face helmet, leather gloves and full length boots.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO TO MY BIKE?

You can ride it to the track then tape up your headlight and indicators, unscrew your mirrors, wire up your centre stand and that's about it - we can help you if necessary. Your bike will be checked for safety. We'll send you more detailed instructions once you have registered.
